



SACRAMENTO SUMMER NIGHT LIGHTS MACK ROAD CAMPUS YOUTH SQUAD LEADER

Sacramento Summer Night Lights (SSNL) is back for 2018! SSNL is a program for youth and families in the Mack Road / Valley Hi neighborhood. As a violence reduction and community development program SSNL targets summer, one of the seasons of greatest need, and those locations historically

impacted by violence.

SSNL will provide extended programming between the hours of 7 p.m. and 10 p.m., three days a week throughout the summer months. Located at Center Parkway and Mack Road, SSNL provides free programming for the entire community. Youth who lives or attends school in the 95823 zip code are eligible to apply. As a “Youth Squad Leader” you will be provided training and linked to educational & employment opportunities beyond the SNL program.

What does the PERFECT YOUTH SQUAD LEADER look like?

Reporting to the Site Supervisor, you will be responsible for supervising a Youth Squad consisting of between four and six members. You will have a great connection with your team and the Mack Road / Valley Hi community. You and your team will set up the site, run the sports programs, participate in the games and workshops, serve food, mediate disagreements, and be a professional ambassador for the program at all times. Even when you are not at work, you will embody the code of ethics of the SSNL. Your job will require you to interact with all members of our community and you will problem solve effectively while remaining calm in the face of many challenges. Conflict resolution skills are a must. Even if you’ve been in trouble in the past, as long as you’re on the right path now, we won’t hold that against you. If this sounds like you, read on and then apply!

Job Requirements

What does the PERFECT YOUTH SQUAD LEADER look like?

Our perfect candidate(s):

- Is between the ages of 18 and 26
- Must live or attend school in the 95823 zip code
- Must have a High School Diploma or GED
- Understands the immediate Mack Road / Valley Hi neighborhood where the SSNL program is being offered
- Is able to work a flexible schedule that includes both days and evenings, sometimes as late as midnight all summer through labor day
- Has two years of experience working with at risk youth
- Is in touch with what’s going on in the community and be ready, willing and able to work hard to serve a diverse population
- Is honest and not afraid of hard work
- Has the respect of their peers which will help us build a successful program
- Is familiar with and comfortable using all forms of social media outreach including but not limited to Facebook, Twitter, text messaging, Instagram, and YouTube
- Is able to work with people from different cultures, neighborhoods and ethnic groups
- Is willing to participate in life skills and youth development training
- Will to establish short and medium range personal development goals
- Will work as part of a team that includes city departments, community organizations, community peacemakers, and law enforcement.
- Is capable of taking and following supervisory directions

- Able to work with SSNL program staff to help plan and implement summer program and events at assigned SSNL site
- A community liaison or neighborhood representative between the program, youth, community residents, local businesses, and law enforcement in promoting safety
- Willing to attend and participate fully in all program trainings, meetings, & planning sessions
- Logical and able to conduct data collection and data entry after receiving related training
- Able to carry out the logistics of leading a team that sets up, breaks down, and closes the SNL program each night
- A cheerful participate in all activities related to food preparation, food delivery, and clean-up for SSNL participants on a daily basis

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete and pass a Live Scan background screening and drug test prior to being provided an official employment offer.
- Proficiency in the use of computers for word processing, simple accounting, spreadsheets, databases, email, and internet.
- Reliable way to get to and from work.
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time, carry a minimum of 30 lbs, and engage in labor intensive activities.

HOURLY WAGE: Hourly wage is \$11.50 per hour with bonus potential. Youth Squad Leaders who work for the duration of the program and pass their evaluation are eligible for the bonus. **Bonus is not guaranteed.** If awarded, will be paid at the end of the summer is at the discretion of the SSNL management staff. Benefits are not available and this is a limited term, summer job only.
